Rules

- A. Judged on the Danish system. All exhibitors will be placed in a blue, red or white group and will receive ribbons accordingly.
- B. All samples competing for premiums in this department must have been grown or helped with growing by exhibitor and during the normal preceding crop harvest. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to see that their products are judged.
- C. Show containers for grains or seeds will be furnished for exhibitors to use.
- D. Grains will be judged with regard to milling, feed or seed value; grasses for forage value. In selecting exhibits the following points should be considered; condition, variety, characteristics, uniformity of size and color, freedom from blemishes and disease, and maturity.
- E. Exhibits from individuals or community exhibits will be allowed to compete in the open classes.
- F. An exhibitor may not make more than one entry of the same variety in the same class.
- G. Exhibits are to be checked in between 8 and 9:30 a.m. Thursday, July 28 with attached entry tag, **except** for the wheat, sunflower and corn shows. These exhibits need to be entered by Monday, July 25 at 4 p.m. (wheat, sunflower, and corn only). These entries need to be taken to the Extension/Fair office with completed entry tag.
- H. This is a terminal show and therefore, samples will not be returned to exhibitors.

- D. This is a terminal show and therefore, samples will not be returned to exhibitors.
