### Rules

- A. This department will be judged on the Danish system. All exhibits will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon.
- B. An exhibit article is not eligible to receive both the Champion and Best of Show awards.
- C. All work must be exhibitor's own work and not previously exhibited at the Kit Carson County Fair.
- D. All articles must be completed within the past year (quilts within the past 5 years).
- E. Only one item per class per person is eligible.
- F. Exhibitors are responsible for completing entry tags prior to entering their exhibits.
- G. Miscellaneous class may not include items from previously listed classes.
- H. When judging the framed needlework exhibits, emphasis will be placed on the quality of the needlework. However, the overall quality of the finished product will be considered, including the frame.
- I. Articles on exhibit must be clean.
- J. Person entering item is responsible for removing it from exhibition building.
- K. Fair management will not be responsible for articles left after release time.

### Best of Show Judging Criteria

- A. Quality; Beauty; Originality
- B. Best of show exhibits will be predominately displayed and will receive a \$25 cash award unless otherwise specified by sponsor. If no exhibit merits the honor, the award will not be given.
- C. Eligible classes (1-41) **Open Class Clothing Best of Show** is being sponsored by K.C.C. Farm Bureau.
- D. Eligible classes (51-186) **Open Class Needlework Best of Show** is being sponsored by Rosie Palkowitsh.
- E. Eligible classes (190-299) **Open Class Quilt Best of Show** is being sponsored by Lazy K Coach.

### Colorado Quilting Council Award

A \$25 cash award and ribbon will be awarded to a first time quilt exhibitor. This award will be chosen by the quilt judge. The cash prize will be mailed within 30 days of the event.
