Rules

- A. Prior entry mandatory (entry deadline, Monday, July 14.) Rabbit and poultry exhibits will be accepted Monday from 1-5 p.m. Exhibits must be in no later than 5 p.m. Late entries will not be accepted.
- B. A grand or reserve grand champion, previously sold in the livestock sale is not eligible in the 4-H show. However, they are eligible to show in open class.
- C. Each exhibitor is allowed no more than two entries per class.
- D. Each rabbit may be shown in **one class** in each division (Meat/Breeding, Fur/Wool, Specialty Divisions). Each rabbit may be shown in a total of **three classes** only **once per division**. Showmanship class is not part of the division count.
- E. All birds will be cooped free in individual coops furnished by the management, according to class.
- F. Any animal showing any symptoms of disease will be barred from exhibit building.
- G. Turkeys, chickens, geese and ducks must be in this year's current hatch only!
- H. Birds entered as pens will not be allowed to compete as singles, or vice-versa.
- I. Birds and rabbits entered in youth classes are not eligible in open classes.
- J. **Meat production** includes Brahma, Langshan, Cochin and Cornish. Dual Purpose includes Plymouth Rock, Wyandotte, Rhode Island Red, Rhode Island White, New Hampshires, Jersey Black Giants, Deleware, Orpington, Sussex, Australorp and Dorking.

Egg production includes Leghorn, Minorca, Ancona and Blue Andalusian. Fancies include Bantams and others not kept for egg or meat production. The assignment to classes of birds not listed above may be made by the superintendent at his/her discretion.

- K. Only the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion poultry and rabbit will be allowed to sell at the livestock sale.
