(Prior to sheep show.)

Rules

- A. Animals must be owned and in continuous care of the exhibitor by May 13, 2009 to be eligible for the Kit Carson County Fair.
- B. Goats must be born after December 1 of the previous year.
- C. Market animals must have milk teeth. Baby teeth must be intact at the time of processing
- D. **NO** bucks of any age will be allowed on the fairgrounds. Only wethers and doelings will be allowed to show.
- E. All market goats are required to have horns tipped not less than the size of a dime. No sharp points allowed.
- F. Does may be shown in either the market or breeding class, but not both.
- G. Breeding goats must be owned by exhibitor.
- H. All breeds will be shown together.
- I. All market goats must be slick shorn (3/8" or less).
- J. Goat entries must be checked in by Monday, August 3 – 9 a.m.
- K. The USDA's Scrapie Eradication Program will be enforced. Goats must have scrapie identification ear tags that list their flock origin. All breeding goats, wethers 18 months of age and older, and all does shown as market goats.
Exception: Registered goats may use tattoos or microchips (EIDs) with Breed Registration Numbers in place of scrapie tags. Registration papers must be provided for verification. Illegible tattoos and non-readable EID's must be replaced with a USDA scrapie I.D. tag. Any goat that requires scrapie tags will not be allowed to unload if tags are not present.
- L. No goat will be unloaded or weighed without having been inspected. Inspections will be conducted at the fairgrounds.
